WHAT IS CULTURAL HERITAGE?

Cultural Heritage is an expression of the ways of living developed by a community and passed on from generation to generation, including customs, practices, places, objects, artistic expressions and values. Cultural Heritage is often expressed as either Intangible or Tangible Cultural Heritage

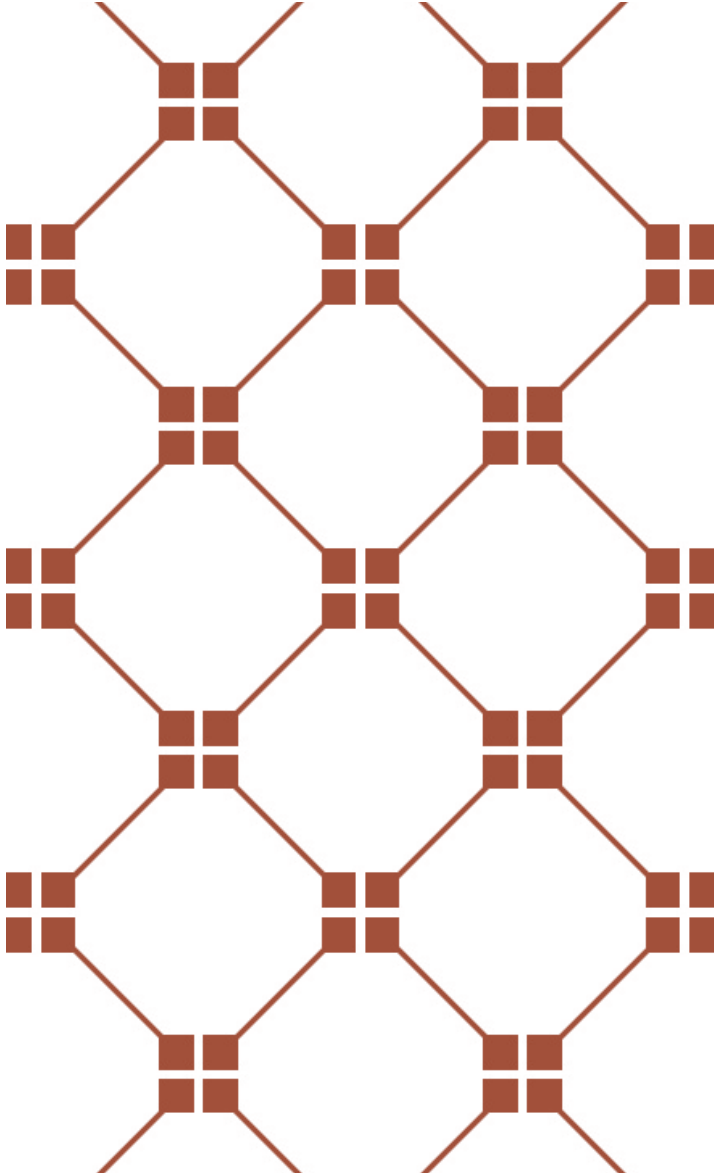

NAMING PRACTICES

Who names the heritages and by what guidelines are they named?

HOW THE HERITAGES ARE NAMED

Named by the CHA/Local governments

Information on the heritage's characteristics or attributes must be included in the name

Therefore, understanding the heritage's name is an important first step to understanding the heritage itself

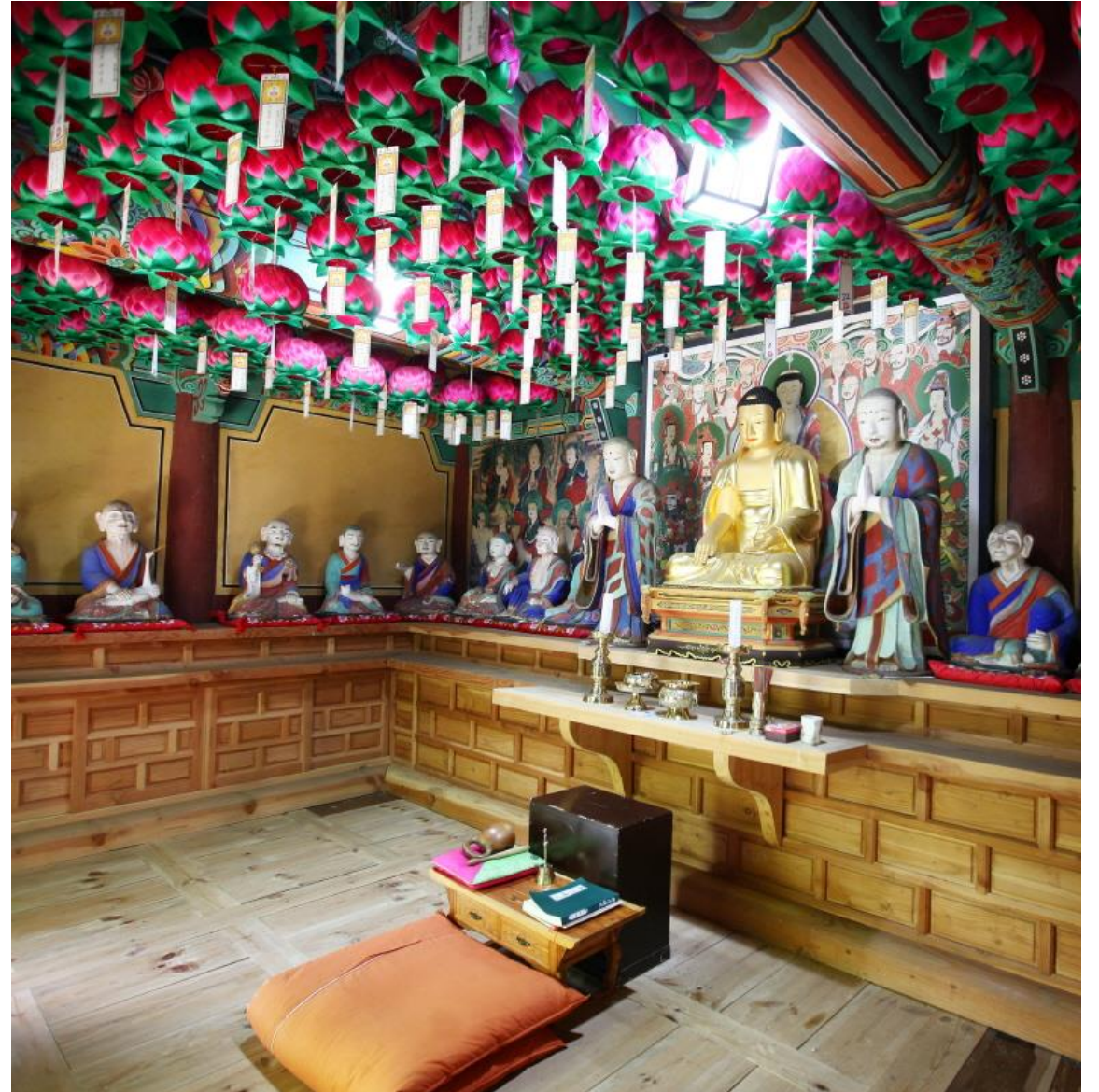

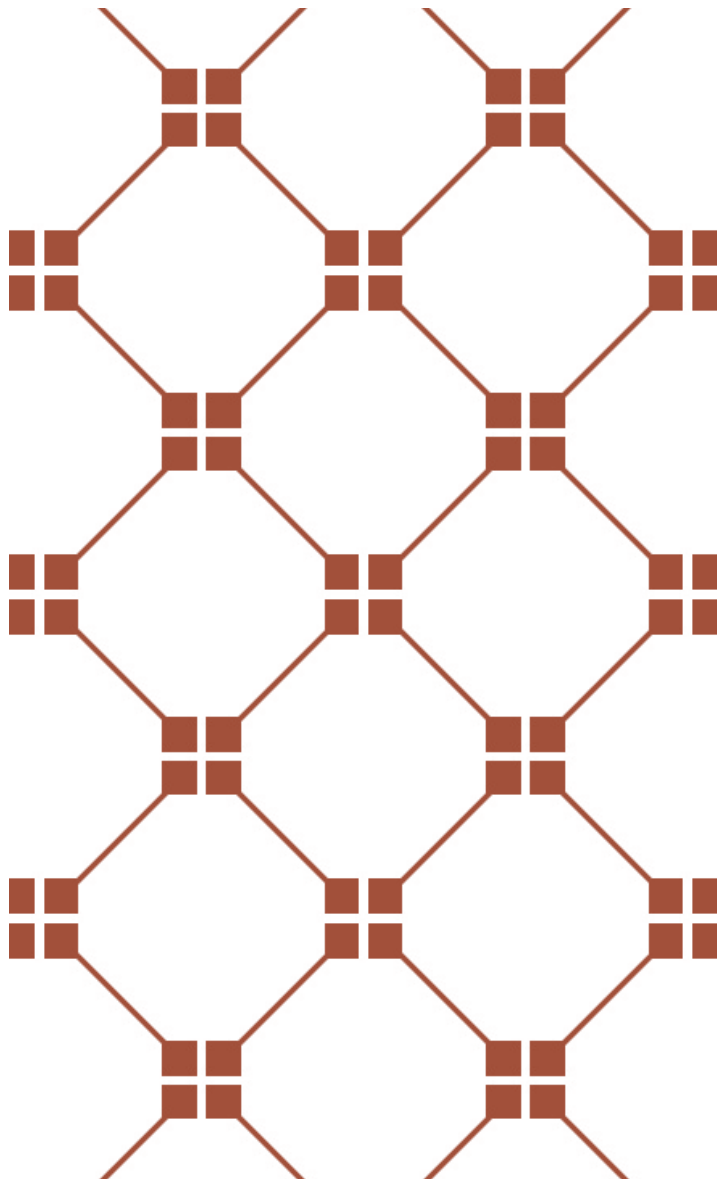

ENGLISH NAMING GUIDELINES

PRIOR TO 2010

No official reference material

- For translating the names of cultural heritages in particular
- Some translation/glossary sites relating to Korean history or tourism
 - Tourism Terminology Foreign Language Glossary / Korea Tourism Organization
 - Korean Studies English Glossary and Thesaurus / Academy of Korean Studies
 - Korean History Terminology English Thesaurus / National History Institute
 - Seoul City Foreign Language Dictionary / Seoul City Government

Growing interest in Korean cultural heritages

- Continued UNESCO heritage designations
- Foreign tourists and international academics

→ Reference material needed

2010-2014

Published a standard guideline and glossary for translating the official titles of the heritages into English



Objective

Provide reference material for translations

Minimize translation errors

Keep the English names consistent with the official Korean titles



Analyzed the Korean names of all ~4,300 state-level designated and registered cultural heritages

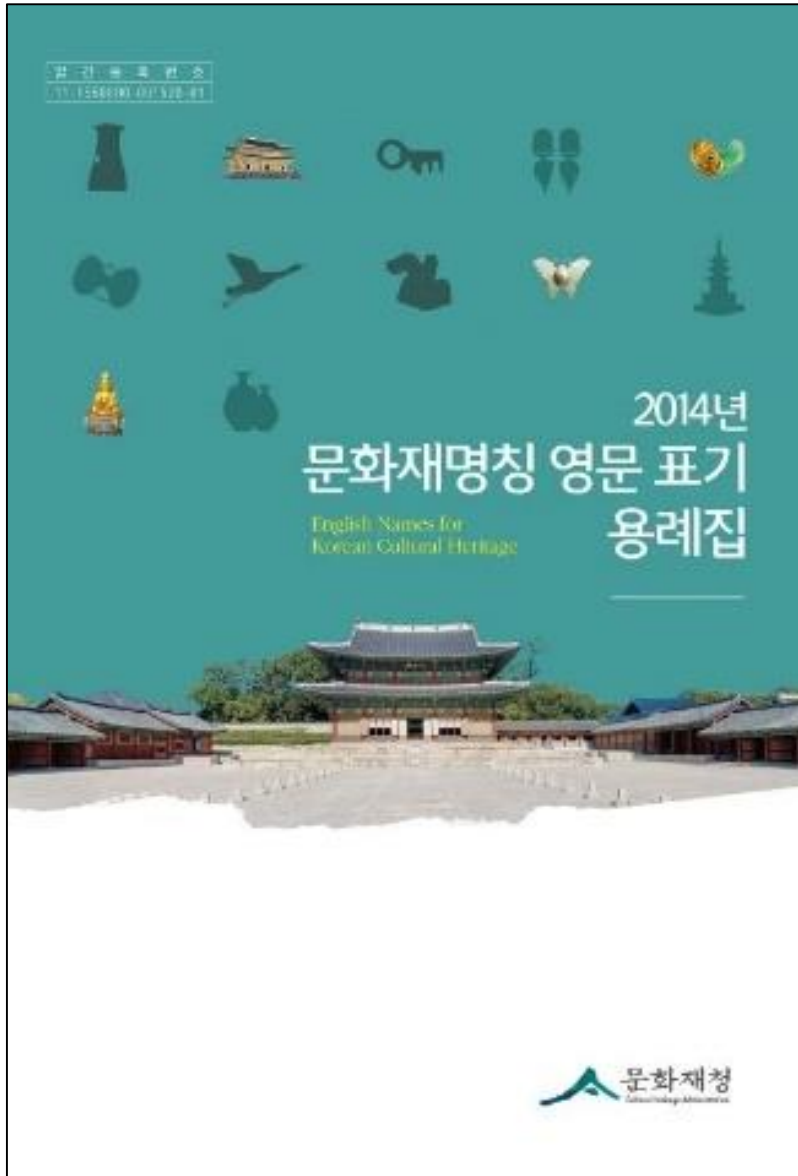


Extracted data on naming elements



Proposed a method for combining the naming elements for each heritage form

Make the existing guideline and glossary content into a database

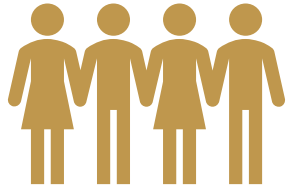

Find the appropriate translations for the individual naming elements

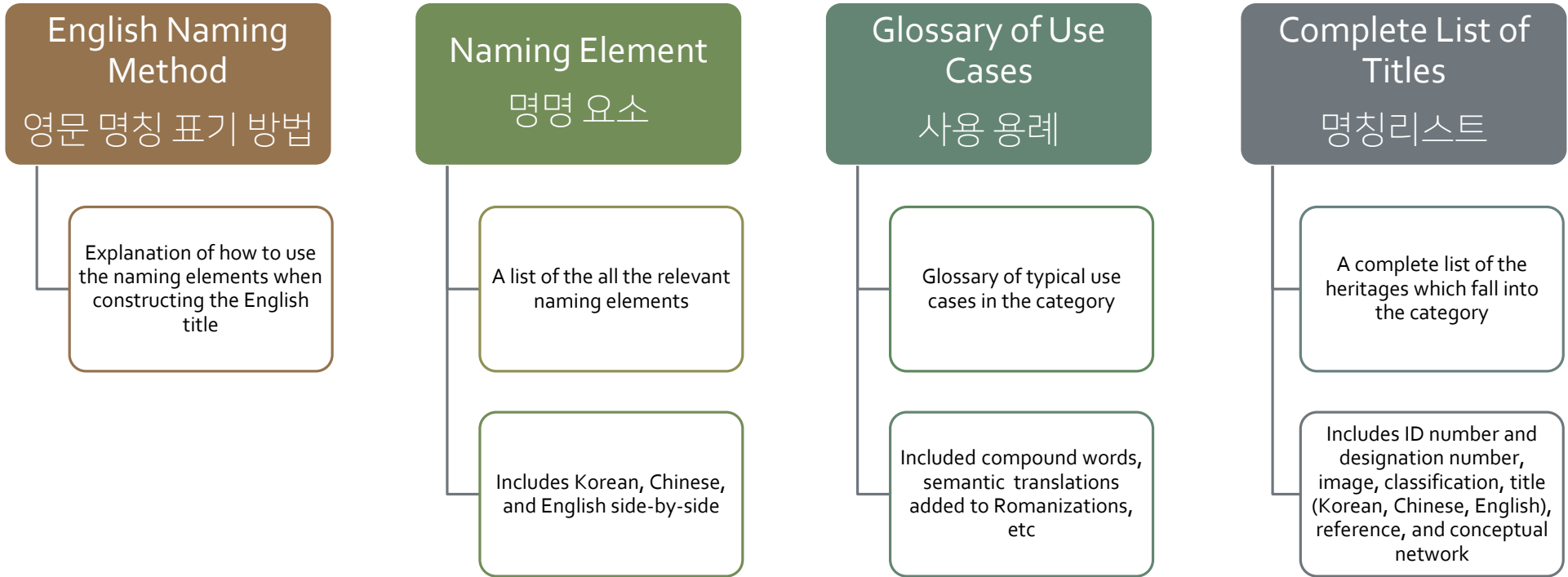
Make it easier to search for similar examples to reference

Visualize how the naming elements are related conceptually

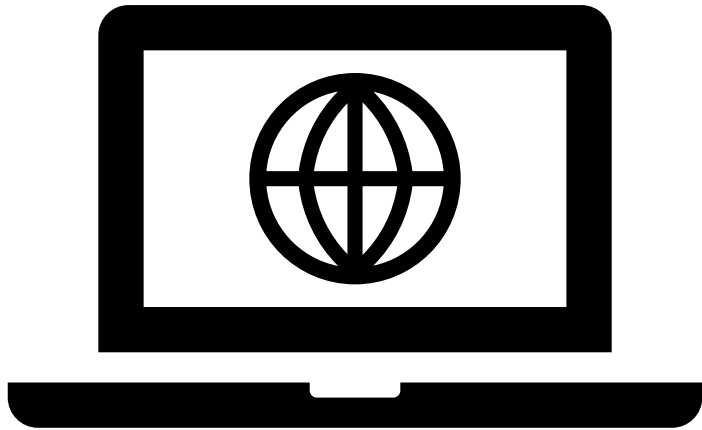

PLANNED FUTURE TASKS TO IMPROVE THE SERVICE



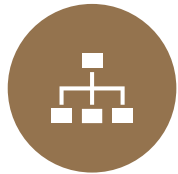
Provide a complete list of current heritages



Make it possible to access the desired information by a simple search



Create a page of all the naming elements



Make it possible to search for all the heritages which include a particular naming element



Add definitions to the naming elements



Add English-language explanations of how to create English titles



Create a semantic network of the naming elements
